Any compatriot in the Arlington, Texas Chapter #7 may contact the Color Guard Locker manager (Sergeant at Arms) and request use of items available.



Think of it as similar to a tuxedo rental only without a fee.


Hopefully, the item(s) available in the locker will continue to grow and we will be able to serve more compatriots.




