CHAPTER MEETING MINUTES

Saturday, December 12, 2020

President Van Fossen called the meeting to order at 9:05am. **Vice President Harrison** outlined the Zoom Meeting instructions: (1) how to mute/unmute, (2) how to voice or hand vote for agenda items at todays meeting. Van Fossen then had Treasurer Nick Harper present the 2021 Proposed Budget for a vote. With no additions or corrections, the 2021 Budget was approved.

Van Fossen turned the meeting over to VP Harrison, who in turn introduced the mornings speaker, returning member the Honorable Allen Clark.

Allen is a 1963 graduate of West Point and a Vietnam War veteran. As a Special Forces Intelligence Officer, he was seriously wounded, loosing both of his legs in a mortar attack in 1967. He has authored 2 previous books about the Vietnam War and in this presentation he was outlining his most recent book, SOLDIER'S BLOOD AND BLOODIED MONEY. This publication chronicles how wars have started and who started them over the last 150 years. He outlined the various political, financial, business, social, and religious causes of these wars. His particular focus for us was on the American Revolution, American Civil War, Spanish American Wars.

After Vietnam' Allen earned his Masters Degree in Finance and Investments at SMU. He worked for the H. Ross Perot organization, for Governor Bill Clements, President George H. W. Bush at the Department of Veterans Affairs as the Asst. Secretary for Veterans Liaison and Director of the National Cemetery System.
