



The 14th Colony of the American Revolutionary War

The colony extended Florida, Georgia, Alabama and Mississippi and contained

only around 7,000. The colony endured years of hardship during this time. Trade was the glue that kept the Indians at bay during this time and allowed the colony to survive.

The British endeavored to aid the colony and tried very hard to help the colony succeed. This colony viewed the American Revolution as someone else's problem. They were struggling to survive and didn't participate in the war.

British West Florida chose not to be a part of the revolution and the British government welcomed their loyalty.

When Galvez arrived he began plotting what he would do when war is

declared he marched on the colony and won in just a few weeks. Galvez prepares a very large army and enters Pensacola Bay. The battle lasted a long time and Galvez succeeded in capturing Pensacola Bay.




New Business – NEW FACE TO FACE/DUAL MEETINGS
