contacting this group to get them to do a program for us. So if you have any ideas that you would like for me to work on for future programs drop me an email and let me know.



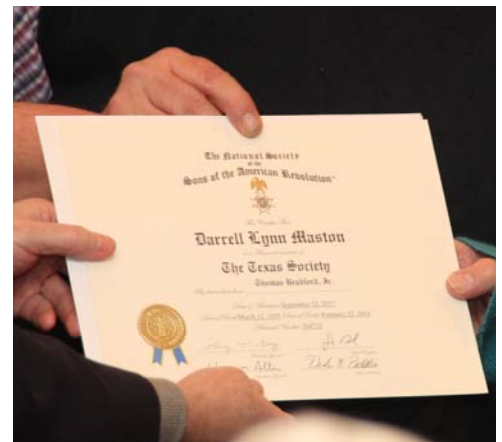
