## THE BRITISH PARLIAMENT PASS THE TEA ACT

On 10 May 1773, The British Parliament passed the TEA ACT, which instituted a tax of three pence per pound on all British tea sold in America, a bill designed to save the faltering East India Company from bankruptcy by greatly lowing the tea tax it paid to the British government, effectively granting a monopoly on the sale of tea in the American Colonies and thereby reducing its excessive stores of tea. Because all "legal" tea had to enter the colonies through England, allowing the East India Company to pay lower taxes in Britain also allowed it to sell tea more cheaply in the colonies. Even untaxed Dutch tea, which entered the colonies illegally through smuggling, was more expensive than East India tea after the act took effect. Many colonists viewed the act as yet another example of taxation tyranny, precisely because it left an earlier duty on tea entering the colonies in place while removing the duty on tea entering England.
