During a heavy storm on their journey to America, John Howland fell overboard. In desperation one of the crew threw over a rope and miraculously John was able to grab hold and be hoisted back on board. The book tells of their landing at Plymouth Rock in 1620 and

the horrible winter that followed. Elizabeth Tilley, only 13 on the journey over with her parents, John Tilley and Joan, married John Howland three years later. The book also talks about the Mayflower Compact and how John was the scrivener. I can't verify that, but it may explain my 52 years as a court reporter, as John Howland is my 8th generation Great Grandfather.


