## CONSTITUTION

## OF THE

## HILL COUNTRY CHAPTER NUMBER

31 TXSSAR

## ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this Chapter shall be "Hill Countrv Chapter Number 31 "of the "Texas Societv Sons of the American Revolution, Inc." (Referred to hereinafter as "Chapter").

## ARTICLE II - OBJECTS

The obiects of this Chapter are declared to be patriotic. historical. and educational and shall include those activities intended or desianed to perdetuate the memory of those who. bv their services or sacrifices durina the War of the American Revolution. achieved the indebendence of the American neonle. Further nurnoses shall be to unite and promote fellowshin amona the descendants of these Revolutionarv ancestors: to inspire them and the communitv at larae with a more profound reverence for the princibles of the aovernment founded bv our forefathers: to encouraae historical research in relation to the American Revolution: to acauire and preserve the records of the individual services of the patriots of the War. as well as documents. relics .and landmarks: to mark the scenes of the Revolution bv appropriate memorials: to celebrate the anniversarv of the prominent events of the War and of the Revolutionarv period: to foster true patriotism: to maintain and extend the institution of American freedom. and to carrv out the purboses expressed in the Preamble of the Constitution of our countrv and the iniunctions of Washinaton in his farewell address to the American people. (See NSSAR Constitution, Part I' Art. II.).

## ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

Anv man shall be eliaible for membership in this Chapter who, beina of the aqe of eiahteen vears or over, and a citizen of aood repute in the communitv, is the lineal descendant of an ancestor who at all times was unfailina in lovaltv to, and rendered assistance to, the cause of American Independence, as defined bv the National Societv Sons of the American Revolution (NSSAR Constitution. Pat I, Art. III), such member shall be designated officially as "Compatriot."

## ARTICLE IV - ORGANIZATION

Section 1.The State Societv is incorborated in the State of Texas as a non-profit corporation. This Chapter, like each of the other State Chapters. is a constituent part of the Incorborated State Societv. As such. the Chapter is not a voluntarv association. nor a subsidiarv-it is simolv a subordinate local bodv oraanized bv the Texas Societv Sons of the American Revolution, Inc. ' for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the Texas Society.

Section 2. The period of duration of this Chapter is perpetual : however. upon surrender. forfeiture. or revocation of the Charter of this Chapter. the Texas Societv's Board of Manaaers (TXSSAR Constitution Art. VIII. Sec. 6) shall act as trustee and take over the real and/or personal property owned and held by the local Chapter at the time of its dissolution.

Section 3. It is understood that the Texas Societv Sons of the American Revolution. Inc.. has unilaterallv decided to be self-insured insofar as liabilitv insurance is concerned. It follows that the Chapter also has no liabilitv insurance to cover anv liabilitv or responsibilitv for such matters. for members and officers acting in pursuit of business of the Society.

## ARTICLE V - OFFICERS

Section 1.The officers of this Chapter shall be 1) President. 2) $1^{\text {st }}$ Vice President. 3) $2^{\text {nd }}$ Vice President 4) Secretarv. 5) Treasurer. 6) Historian. 7) Reaistrar. 8) Seraeant at Arms. and 9) Chaplain. The above named officers. toaether with all Past Presidents. will combrise the Chapter Executive Committee. The offices of Secretary, Treasurer, Historian and Registrar may be held by the same person.

Section 2. All nominations of officers shall be made from the floor. Nominations made bv a committee appointed for such purpose shall be considered nominations from the floor.

Section 3. Officers shall be elected bv maioritv vote of the members (Compatriots) present at the Annual Meetina of the Chapter (Januarv) reaular meetina) and shall hold office for a period of one year following their installation (March regular meeting).

Section 4. Should a vacancv occur durina a term of office. the Executive Committee shall appoint a replacement and notify the membership of its action at the next regular Chapter meeting.

Section 5. In order to protect further the tax-exempt status of this Chapter. it is herebv declared that candidates for public office or elected public officials shall not hold office in the Chapter. All other aspects of active Chapter membership may be enjoyed by such members.

## ARTICLE VI - MEETINGS

Section 1.Regular meetings shall be scheduled monthlv at convenient times and locations as set bv the Executive committee.. The Annual Meetina of the Chapter is desianated to be in Januarv. when officers shall be elected. No reaular meetinas shall be held in June. Julv. Auaust. and December. Notifications of the time. date. and place of meetings shall be made by mail, E-mail or telephone, in advance of such meetings.

Section 2.Conduct of meetinas shall follow procedures outlined in the NSSAR Handbook, as applicable. Members are welcome to brina auests and are responsible for the cost of meals for themselves and their auests. Compatriots from other SAR Chapters. DAR ladies, and CAR's are welcome auests. provided thev defrav anv costs related to their attendance. Fees for quest speakers are prohibited, excent for the cost of the speaker's meal. which shall be borne bv the Chapter. Complimentarv meals mav be provided other invited guests, as approved by the Chapter Executive Committee.

Section 3. Special meetinas mav be called. with proper advance notification. bv the President. At the President's prearranaed direction. or in the event of his inabilitv or incapacitv to perform his duties. a maioritv of the Chapter Executive Committee may call special meetings to transact Chapter business, as may be required.

Section 4. Reaularlv scheduled Chapter meetinas mav be held without a auorum. However. the transaction of Chapter business shall reauire a auorum: such quorum shall comprise at least ten percent of the Chapter membership.

Section 5. The official Chapter Proaram Year shall commence in March. immediatelv followina election of officers, and end on the last day of February of the following year.

## ARTICLE VII - AMENDMENTS

This Chapter Constitution may be superseded by a new Constitution, amended or in any way changed, at any regular or special meeting of the Chapter called for that purpose. The proposed new Constitution or Amendment(s) shall be read in final form, and any changes voted shall be incorporated therein upon final adoption. A two-thirds vote of members present shall be required for adoption.

## ARTICLE VIII - EFFECTIVE DATE

This Constitution shall be in full force immediately upon its adoption, and the meeting at which it is adopted shall be governed thereby. It is understood that, at all times, this Constitution must conform to that of the Texas Society Sons of the American Revolution, Inc. This Chapter Constitution may be superseded by a new Constitution, amended or in any way changed, at any regular or special meeting of the Chapter called for that purpose. The proposed new Constitution or Amendment(s) shall be read in final form, and any changes voted shall be incorporated therein upon final adoption. A two-thirds vote of members present shall be required for adoption.
