Vietnam War 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Commemoration "Fifty Years ago in History"

Beginning in 2014, the Sons of the American Revolution along with the U. S. Defense Department is commemorating the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Vietnam War. Our chapter is part of this commemoration program. As part of that event, the chapter will look back at events from the Vietnam War that occurred during a particular month from the Vietnam War era.

The year 2016 is like looking back 50 years to when Vietnam was either in the near future for many of you, or was already a reality This is a sampling of what **occurred in this month (May) during the Vietnam War**, some fifty years ago:

May 1961 1st Army Security Agency Contingent arrives in South Vietnam

May 20, 1964 Marine Detachment Advisory Group One arrives in South Vietnam

May 7, 1965 First Ground combat unit (173<sup>rd</sup> Airborne Brigade) deploys to South Vietnam

May 31, 1967 CIA flies surveillance in operation BLACK SHIELD using Lockheed A-12 Blackbird

May 1, 1970 President Nixon authorizes the use of B-52 bombers in Cambodia

May 12, 1975 A Khmer Rouge gunboat seized the American ship, USS Mayaguez, in the Gulf of Thailand. The crew was release on May 15<sup>th</sup>.

The chapter will induct a new member, Ron Turner, at the May 21<sup>st</sup> meeting. Ron is military veterans having served in the US Navy from 1969 to 1973 as a communications technician interpreter/translator for both French and Thai language while stationed in the Philippines, including support for Henry Kissinger during the Paris peace talks of 1973.

The chapter is continuing to provide support for a number of 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary Vietnam Veteran recognition events with several planned in May at church services of our chapter members. Veterans will be recognized at these events in Weatherford, Aledo and Arlington. Hope to see you at the May chapter meeting where our speaker will be a representative of the VA who will discuss employment initiatives for veterans.
