Patricia Thibodeau, Speaking on the subject, The Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. Born in Alabama, in the military 14 years, has children in the military, a member of a variety of organizations, has spoken to many different groups.

The **Tomb of the Unknown Soldier** is a monument dedicated to deceased U.S. service members whose remains have not been identified. It is located in Arlington National Cemetery in Virginia, United States. The World War I "Unknown" is a recipient of the Medal of Honor, the Victoria Cross, and several other foreign nations' highest service awards. The U.S. Unknowns who were interred are also recipients of the Medal of Honor, presented by U.S. presidents who presided over their funerals. The monument has no officially designated name. The DAR places a wreath there yearly as does a number of other organizations.
