- Tom Milson Wreaths across America: Tom has spoken with the representative of the Cemetery Association in Melissa who we dealt with last year, there is about 100 veterans buried there. We have about 20 30 wreaths that will carry over from last year. The McKinney SAR Chapter will not be taking any profit, instead the program we signed up for will provide extra wreaths, so it is 2 for \$15 plus the extra wreath, so really we are getting 3 wreaths for \$15. Tom will send directions to event to participate.

- Tom Milson read report from Bob Johns, Plano Chapter Bob coordinates with John Greer, Veteran Affairs of McKinney Chapter, on working with the Bonham VA. Since that time, we have received \$40.00 from two dual chapter membership dues. The bank balance is currently at \$6704.44." Tom Milson, advised that he believes the McKinney Chapter SAR made around \$1500 as a result of the silent auctions at the Board of Managers meeting and we expect to receive that from the state soon.
