John's military experience spans 30 years in the US Army as an Armor and Cavalry officer. He is a graduate of the United States Military Academy at West Point. John is an award-winning Amazon best selling author of 16 books and hundreds of magazine articles about leadership, history and war. During his career he commanded combat soldiers at every level from platoon to regiment. In 2003 he was the founding editorial director for the military history magazine Armchair General, where he continues today as a contributing editor. An accomplished writer and military historian, Colonel Antal's credits include Armor Attacks, Proud Legions, and Forests of Steel.
