2022 Youth Contests

The Robert Rankin Chapter is very active in youth programs. At the state level, Chapter sponsored contestants have placed regularly. Essays have won first place and third place. A strong year for Rankin sponsored contestants, Noah Hagler placed second in 2020. A sponsored poster won second place in 2020 & 2021. Again in 2020 & 2021 we had a sister and brother, Kate and Mattew Jeong both place first in the state brochure contest, respectively, with Matthew going on to place third in the national contest.

Each year the Chapter also recognizes outstanding JROTC cadets by awarding Bronze JROTC medals and certificates at every high school in the Cypress-Fairbanks Independent School District with a JROTC program. In 2005, Eagle Scout certificates were mailed to over 30 new Eagle Scouts living in the Katy Independent School District. In 2006, the Robert Rankin Chapter received the Group 1 (10-39 members) Outstanding Chapter award, largely because of its enthusiastic participation in these educational and patriotic programs during 2005, which we hope to get going again.



Victoria Smith was the firstplace winner of both the 2021 Robert Rankin Chapter C.A.R. SAR Contest and Knight Essay Contest, finishing 2nd in the Texas State C.A.R. contest. She was elected National 1st Vice President at the 2022 C.A.R. State Convention.
