A beautiful spot has been designated for the *Never Forget Garden Veterans Memorial* in the Brazos Valley Veterans Memorial. Features are:

- Size 21' x 30'
- 7 foot granite monument with wreath
- · Large granite star in the plaza center
- Engraved brick pavers on the inside border
- Two granite pedestals, one on each side of the entrance to the memorial
- Flowers and trees native to the area
- Never Forget Garden plaque
- Wrought iron bench at garden entrance
