There is a shuttle available and it is a great hotel with a negotiated daily rate of \$115. We have rooms reserved for Thursday, Friday and Saturday for your convenience, if you wish to do some sightseeing around the city outside of the meeting. Some of the attractions are the DOC Museum only a block or so away. "Doc" is a fully restored and flying B-29 and at this time I cannot say for sure that "Doc" will be in town as they are still setting the calendar for events they will be taking it to. Yes, you can get a flight on the plane when they are giving rides. There is a Tank collection recommended by the visitor's bureau that I have not yet seen but the collector has a huge collection both inside and outside of tanks from all wars and countries around the world from what I understand. The Museum of World Treasures is in Old Town and it is another super museum. The Ladies will be taking in the Wichita Art Museum where General Admission is free with a nice restaurant and Museum Store as well. We will have a list of many other attractions around the area that are really nice and one can spend days taking in the sights without going far from the hotel for those that wish to vacation a bit while here.
